- 8 A natural arch formed by trees/ vines/boulders/rock formations
- * Might be spanning a gap, or be purely ceremonial

d20 Temple is centred on

- 3 A constructed altar (see below)
- 4 A boulder/rock outcropping
- 5 A spring
- 6 An ancient statue
- 7 The base of a cliff
- 8 A view from a hill/cliff/mountain
- 9 A waterfall (top? bottom?)
- 10 The entrance of a cave/complex
- 11 An open hilltop
- 12 A clearing in a thick forest/jungle
- 13 An island *
- 14 A grove of trees
- 15 A large stump of an ancient tree
- 16 On the shore of a lake/river/ ocean
- 17 A thicket in a forest
- 18 A relic from a forgotten civilization **
- 19 A tree-covered mound
- 20 A structure (See below)
- * On/overlooking the island
- ** A pillar, ruin, animal statue, etc.

d8 Altar consists of

- A simple pile of natural stones, gathered from the nearby area
- 2 A massive, flat stone resting on a base of three large tree trunks
- 3 A round flat stone with a large hole in the middle, resting on four solidly made stone pillars
- 4 A block constructed of handmade bricks
- 5 A substantial block of wellhewn stones, with tall pillars at the four corners
- 6 A large split log resting on a solidly built wooden base
- 7 A structure of well-hewn stones, built with a gutter down the middle to carry the blood and/or fluid away
- 8 A single, massive rock, intricately carved with hellish symbols

d8 Structure (see shape)

- 1 Solid ceiling supported by columns, no walls *
- 2 Columns around the perimeter, no roof *
- 3 A tall wall *
- 4 A short wall *
- 5 An open (lattice) ceiling supported by columns *
- 6 A wooden palisade
- 7 A henge (earth/wood/stone)
- 8 Columns/markers at the cardinal points *
- * Could be covered with vines, ivy, etc.

d6 Shape of the temple

- 1 Circle
- 2 Oval
- 3 Square
- 4 Rectangle
- 5 Star
- 6 Irregular

• d8 Temple dedicated to

- 1 The god/spirit present in the local area/feature
- 2 Animals (all? a specific species? an individual? mythic?)
- 3 Plant life (all? a specific species? an individual?)
- 4 Elements (air, earth, fire, water)
- 5 A local natural phenomenon
- 6 Elemental forces (weather, tides, wind, etc.)

- 7 A specific pantheon (emphasizing nature related gods?)
- 8 Nature as a whole *
- * Prayers to any nature god are welcomed

d10 Background for location

- 1 Natural beauty or uniqueness
- 2 A saint/prophet had a divine encounter here *
- 3 A saint/prophet rescued by natural forces here *
- 4 On a natural, significant boundary
- 5 A god/the gods commanded a temple be built here *
- 6 The builder sensed the presence of a god/spirit in this location

- 5 Effective blessings (for birth/ revenge/a boon/inner peace)
- 6 To ask a god favour
- * In a tree, on a cliff/stone, etc.; might only be accessible to adherents

d6 Visitors come to see

- 1 The holy/beautiful site
- 2 The wildlife attracted to this place
- 3 The birthplace of a mysterious religion
- 4 The rare natural plants that grow here
- 5 The historical grounds
- 6 The famous gardens

d12 Worship accoutrements

- 1 A stone/wood lectern
- 2 Torch stands
- 3 Sacred texts *
- 4 Ceremonial knife for sacrifices *
- 5 Handbells/chimes *
- 6 Robes and other vestments *
- 7 Various musical instruments for use during worship d6 *
 - 1 cymbals
 - 2 rattles
 - 3 flute or pipes
 - 4 horn
 - 5 drum(s) (with drumsticks?)
 - 6 lute/mandolin/other stringed instrument
- 8 Ropes/straps/manacles/other restraints for holding sacrifice victims (human, animal, whatever) in position during the ceremony *
